The house has been reconstructed in a fully environmentally controllable chamber, in which climatic conditions can be maintained, varied, repeated and patterns monitored. For the test, the inside temperature of the Energy House was 25°C with an exterior temperature of 5°C. All energy ratings are indicative only.

## Indicative U-Values

The indicative U-Values throughout our brochure are based on a specification including: Distinction Signature PVC edgebanded door leaf, 70x70mm PVC frame with steel reinforcement and a thermally broken aluminium threshold using non-Low E glass. Differences from this specification may affect the value considerably.

## Heritage Lock

The Heritage lock also features slam shut locking, but replaces the contemporary bar handle with a traditional finger pull and thumb-turn escutcheon plate.

Available in PVD chrome, PVD brass and satin chrome finishes.

\*Minimum door width to accept the Heritage Lock is 870mm overall.







## Contemporary Lock

Make a statement with a modern bar handle. Available in a range of lengths, these handles compliment the midpoint locking position of the Contemporary lock, and ooze style and quality with their stainless steel construction. In addition to looking great, these handles and the ease of operation are available fitted inside and out, or to the outside only.

When your door is in the closed position, always lift the handle set to engage the deadbolt and hooks. This will help with keeping your door aligned in the correct frame position and help to combat thermal movement.



In order to comply with your warranty and to prolong the life of the surface, a small amount of care and attention is needed. How often will depend on where you live. In a coastal or heavily industrialised area or near a main road, cleaning may need to be more often.

We recommend that you only use warm soapy water (washing up liquid is suitable) with a lint free cloth and wipe dry with a soft clean cloth for the doors surface, as well as a little lubrication for operational parts; lock, hinges. Please refer to our 'Operation, Cleaning and Maintenance' instructions on our Website.

- Use pressure washers or steam cleaners
- Apply any type of bleach or solvent
- Apply any adhesives of any type or tack
- Have any contact with any sharp objects
